New Student Fees

Application Fee (non-refundable*)	\$ 25	Paid at the time the application is submitted online
Registration Fee (non-refundable*)	\$250	Due and payable within five (5) business days of acceptance
Technology Fee (non-refundable*)	\$260	Due and payable within five (5) business days of acceptance
High School Retreat (Grades 9–12)	\$395	Retreat is mandatory; billed October 1

Returning Student Fees

Reenrollment Fee (non-refundable*)	\$250	The reenrollment fee is paid online when submitting your reenrollment, which is due by February 1 in order to take advantage of Family Preference. Family Preference applies only to presently enrolled, returning families.
Technology Fee (non-refundable*)	\$260	Billed in March and due April 1
High School Retreat (Grades 9–12)	\$395	Retreat is mandatory; billed October 1

Computer Requirement

Students need a computer at home; FCS Chromebooks are used for classroom activities. In some cases, students are welcome to use their own device in class. Students may bring their own device to school, if approved by their parent. We suggest the following for a student device:

- Wi-Fi capable
- iOS (Apple) or Android platform
- Chrome browser (free download)
- Easy to transport
- Large enough screen and keyboard to create and edit documents

Examples of devices that will work well:

- Tablet (iOS or Android based) with a Chrome web browser
- Chromebook
- Laptop with a Chrome web browser

Tuition Payment Programs

Tuition is an annual fee.

New Families: One-tenth (1/10) of the annual fee (also called the “first tuition payment”), as well as the application, registration, and technology fees, are non-refundable* and due within five (5) business days of the date of the acceptance letter.

Returning Families Entering Transitional Kindergarten or Kindergarten: Within five (5) business days of the date of the admissions offer letter, the non-refundable* enrollment fee, technology fee, and the first month’s tuition is due.

There are two payment programs from which to choose:

1. Single Payment: If tuition is paid in full by August 3, a 3% discount is given (see above chart). This discount is also available to new families within five (5) business days of acceptance but before the first day of school.
2. Scheduled Payments: Equal payments in 10 or 12 installments, beginning as early as July 1 and ending no later than June 1.
